


If you have **NOT** yet submitted the common application, **begin by completing the application**.


In the **Career Goals Section**, you must select <u>at least one</u> of the "teaching-related" options for this question:




In the Athletics, Community Service, and Employment section, the student must answer "YES" to this question:

TEACHING FELLOWS PROGRAM

Application Requirements

Students, Minimum qualifications and applicable rules:

Applicants must:

- · plan to pursue a career in education.
- · work with a specific SRJC Faculty Mentor to submit a joint application to the Teaching Fellows program
- complete a minimum of 24 degree applicable units at SRJC by the end of the spring term in which they apply to the program.
- have a 3.0 or greater overall GPA (including any coursework transferred to SRJC). Applicants with an overall GPA below 3.0, but who have earned a 3.0 or higher for the past two consecutive academic terms, should contact the Scholarship Office to request an appeal for consideration by the Teaching Fellows Steering Committee.
- plan to enroll in and complete a minimum of 24 units at SRJC during the academic year in which they are
 Teaching Fellows, including at least 6 units during each of the Fall and Spring semesters. Applicants may appeal
 to have units earned during the summers before or after that academic year be counted as part of the 24 units.
- Fellows must maintain a minimum overall GPA of 3.0 during the year of Program participation.

Faculty Mentors, Requirements:

Faculty Mentors must be a contract faculty member or an associate faculty member sponsored by a contract faculty member. Should the associate faculty member be unable to complete the program, the sponsoring contract faculty member will serve as the Mentor.


APPLICATION MATERIALS

Students will submit an application and an essay. The application sends an auto-generated request for a letter of recommendation to a faculty member identified by the student.

Begin by briefly describing your interest in teaching.

- · What you plan to do in your career
- · What you hope to accomplish in the Teaching Fellows Program

Your essay must demonstrate:

- · an interest or emerging interest in pursuing a career in education
- · an understanding of the goals and objectives of the Teaching Fellows program
- · a sense of self-awareness and reflectivity
- a sense of commitment to the program and a willingness and ability to follow through with the requirements of the program
- an ability to articulate and communicate ideas clearly and with confidence


